Date & Location

You should have received the date of your capsule endoscopy from our practice by phone, through the portal, and/or email and text messaging. If you do not know your procedure date please contact our practice.

Shopping List

Our practice can provide a kit containing all medications needed for your capsule endoscopy for \$15 or you can purchase them over the counter:

- □ One (1) 238-gram (8.3 oz) bottle of MiraLAX (or generic named polyethylene glycol 3350)
- □ Two (2) 80 milligram tablets of simethicone <u>or</u> one (1) 250 milligram tablets of Phazyme
- □ Sixty-four (64) ounces of clear liquid which may include: Gatorade, Pedialyte, water, lemonade, clear fruit juices, clear (no coloring) soft drinks, seltzer water (please avoid red or purple-colored beverages)
